WORKSHOP: Living Flower Arrangements with Layers of Bulbs

We all smile when we receive a beautiful arrangement of flowers. However, that smile will return many times when we realize that the flowers come from live bulbs and will last up to 2 or 3 times longer than cut flowers. Then they can often be recycled into the garden after danger of hard freeze. This lecture covers the particulars on how to do it and which bulb cultivars are best suited to pot culture. We will demonstrate the most innovative methods of creating the forced container, the window box liner, the layered patio planter or individually potted bulbs. This workshop should expand our gardening palette and give us more hours of garden pleasure, an additional season and flowers in additional areas. A 'hands-on' workshop follows the lecture where participants will get the opportunity to create their own combination planting which they may take home and enjoy watching become their 'Living Flower Arrangement'. Includes 12" pot and 5 layers of bulbs to take home.
